**1. By-law No. 1019, Amendment to Zoning By-law No. 899 for Lot 19, Block 7, Plan 2871 (ZBA 25-003)**

Riel Brouillette, City Planner, presented By-law No. 1019, Amendment to Zoning By-law No. 899 for Lot 19, Block 7, Plan 2871 (ZBA 25-003). Mr. Brouillette explained that the amendment was to permit a small accessory retail store in Apex.

Mayor Awa asked if any representations were received by the Planning Department.

Mr. Brouillette pointed out that the by-law was modified between readings, therefore this was the second Public Hearing on the matter. He advised that during the first Public Hearing, two Apex residents, Jarrett Parker and Amoudla Koutoo, wrote to the Planning Department in support of the accessory retail store.

Mr. Brouillette explained that the by-law was modified to allow for the inclusion of a shed, and a new public notice was distributed.

Mr. Brouillette advised that in advance of this Public Hearing, another Apex resident, Kerry McClusky, wrote to the Planning Department expressing support for the project. The Planning Department did not receive any other representations from the public.
