
#### **Alternative Date in Case of Inclement Weather:**

In the event of poor weather, the cleanup will be postponed to Friday, June 20, 2025. A notice will be posted by the City the day before, or the morning of, cleanup day if the event is being rescheduled.

Cleanup kits, including gloves, garbage bags, and safety instructions, will be available at the Unnikkarvik Visitor Centre. Residents may clean in any part of the city.

If you are participating outside of the scheduled date or time, please call the City to let us know where your garbage bags are located. Ensure they are placed close to the road or in clearly accessible locations, so staff can safely collect them.

We encourage residents, businesses, and community groups to participate. Whether it is cleaning around your home, your workplace, or a nearby public area, every contribution counts.





All cleanup participants are invited to enjoy a community BBQ and take part in our prize draws as a thank you for helping keep Iqaluit clean and beautiful.

Please remember to dress for the weather, use caution when handling waste, and supervise children during cleanup activities.
