## Household Hazardous Waste Drop Off – Tundra Valley

**October 20, 2025 – Iqaluit, Nunavut**

The City of Iqaluit would like to remind residents of the Household Hazardous Waste drop off point open **Saturday October 25, 2025, from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. in Tundra Valley between house 2561 and 2453**. This event provides residents an opportunity to safely dispose of their Household Hazardous Waste.

Household hazardous waste includes many items that people are storing in their garages, kitchens, or bathrooms and are no longer needed. Hazardous items are often toxic or flammable which means extra care should be taken when disposing of them.

The public is encouraged to take advantage of the hazardous waste collection day by coming out and safely disposing of these unwanted or unusable items.

### **Household items to be accepted (include but are not limited to):**

Anti-freeze, Adhesives, Aerosols, Automotive and Household Batteries, Cleaners, Corrosives, Fuels, Mercury, Oxidizers, Poisons, Paint Cans and Spray Paint, Pharmaceuticals, Solvents

### **Items not accepted:**

Electronics waste, used oil, oil filters, oil containers, tires, propane tanks, biological waste, infectious waste, radioactive waste, explosives, ammunition and industrial waste.

Residents are asked to keep the labels on the materials brought for disposal. This helps to identify the substances for proper disposal and avoids the need for testing substances.
