

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF IQALUIT
BY-LAW No. 662
AMENDMENT TO GENERAL PLAN BY-LAW No. 571

A By-law of the City of Iqaluit in Nunavut to amend By-law No. 571, The City of Iqaluit General Plan, pursuant to the Planning Act, R. S. N. (1988), c. P-7, s. 29

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of Iqaluit has adopted a General Plan, (By-law No. 571) in accordance with the Planning Act, and

WHEREAS Council wishes to amend the General Plan to protect from development the Right of Way for the future By-Pass Road.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Iqaluit enacts as follows:

1. Schedule A of this By-law is declared to form part of this By-law.
2. Section 6.3.3 is hereby amended by deleting Delete the introductory paragraph in that section and replacing it with the following paragraph:


"Council has long considered the need for a By-pass Road linking Niaqunngusiaq Road (in the vicinity of Inukshuk High School) to Federal Road in order to alleviate traffic congestion and truck traffic at the Four Corners. The Transportation and Urban Design Study (2005) recommends a reconfiguration of the Niaqunngusiaq Road and Kangiq & Iniq Drive intersection and a future road alignment that extends Kangiq & Iniq Drive north with potential connections to Federal Road via Masak Court, Sikituuq Court or further north as shown on Figure D of this Plan."

3. Add the following policy to Section 6.3.3:

"2. Road widenings, to achieve a road right of way of up to 25 metres for the future By-Pass Road, as shown on Figure D, shall be obtained at the time of redevelopment, new development or subdivision of land, or when Council approves funding for the By-Pass Road, whichever comes first."

4. Figure D of By-law No.571 containing the Primary Road Network is hereby amended as shown on Schedule A of this By-law.
5. This By-law shall come into effect on the date of its third reading.

READ a first time this 28th day of August, 2007.





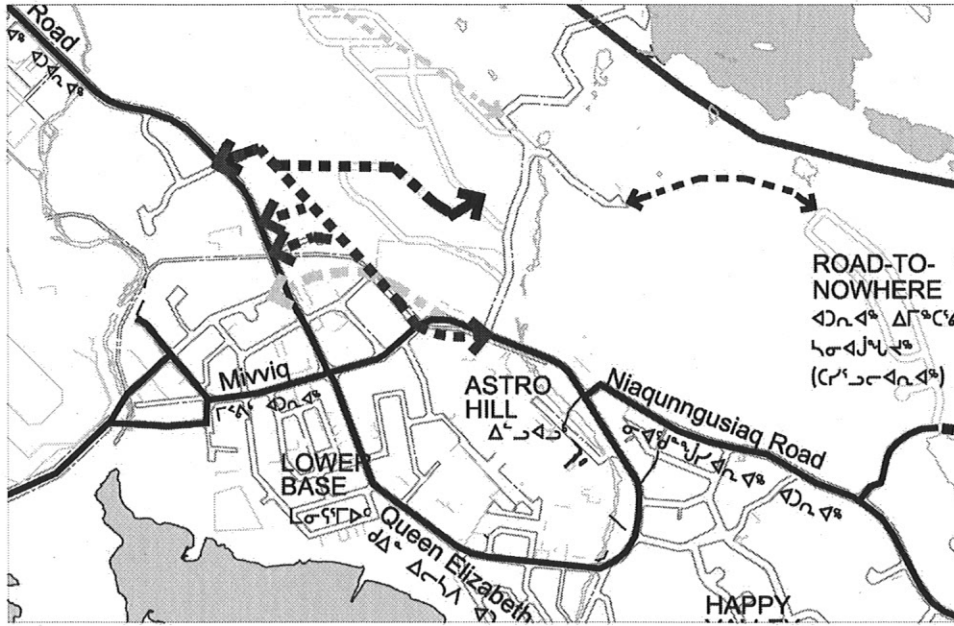
