ITEM DESCRIPTION ACTION

Question 1.1:

We have a highly qualified and experienced candidate to put forward with considerable project experience on municipal infrastructure projects and most recently with the Government of the Northwest Territories. The prospective candidate has a Bachelor of Civil Engineering and is registered Professional Licensee Engineering (P.L. Eng.) in British Columbia and Alberta. We understand that Northwest Territories and Nunavut Association of Professional Engineers and Geoscientists presently does not have a legislation in place to accommodate limited licensees. As such:

- 1. Would a registered Professional Licensee Engineering (P.L. Eng.) in British Columbia and Alberta be an acceptable candidate to the City of Igaluit? If not;
- 2. Would a registered Professional Licensee Engineering (P.L. Eng.) in British Columbia and Alberta be an acceptable candidate to the City of Iqaluit under supervision by a Professional Engineer registered with NAPEG?

Response 1.1:

As a candidate, the City would accept a registered Professional Engineer licensed in another Province or Territory who will work under supervision of a Professional Engineer registered with NAPEG and be able to obtain the required license in Nunavut within the first 6 months.
