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Addendum 1 is hereby issued to amend the *2026-RFP-008 Waste Management Services*. The changes outlined in this addendum shall take precedence over the original document.

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### **Question 1.1**

Do you interpret the ICI as including the construction waste from the many new builds that are going on in town at present and into the future?

### **Answer 1.1**

No. For clarity, ICI waste collection referenced in the RFP does not include the collection or hauling of construction, renovation, demolition, development, or other site-generated waste from active construction or development projects.

The successful Proponent will not be responsible for providing site waste collection or hauling services for active construction sites, new builds, renovations, demolitions, or development projects. Responsibility for the collection, hauling, and disposal of such waste remains with the applicable contractor, developer, property owner, or other responsible party.

However, where construction, renovation, demolition, development, or other site-generated waste is delivered to a City waste facility in accordance with applicable City requirements, the successful Proponent shall be responsible under the RFP for receiving, managing, processing, and/or directing the material at the facility. This includes, but is not limited to, compliance with applicable diversion requirements, segregation requirements, disposal procedures, and site operating requirements.

Proponents shall prepare their submissions accordingly.

### **Question 1.2**

Is there a specific time for the visit? Will you be touring with one proponent at a time? And does the visit include the West 40 landfill, North 40 landfill and WTS? Do you need in advance the names of the people that will be attending?

### **Answer 1.2**

An optional site visit is tentatively scheduled for June 3, 2026. Proponents who wish to participate must confirm their attendance by email to the City Representative(s) identified in Section 2.2 of the RFP on or before June 1, 2026.



The confirmed time, meeting location, and any applicable site access requirements will be provided to proponents following receipt of their attendance confirmation.

The site visit is expected to include the West 40 Landfill, North 40 Landfill, and Waste Transfer Station (WTS). The site visit will be conducted with all confirmed proponents at the same time, rather than individually.

Proponents are requested to provide the names of the individuals who will be attending when confirming participation.

Please note that if no confirmations of attendance are received by the deadline, the City may cancel the site visit and no site visit will be held.
