Clarification Questions

Q1: Is there any flexibility on the overall project schedule, to allow some follow up interviews or events in the fall?

A1: Yes, the City will allow some flexibility for follow up interviews or events in the fall.

Q2: Will the City provide translation/interpretation services for other public communications beyond the workshop identified in the RFP? This could be events, web-based tools, or paper flyers/surveys, for example.

A2: Yes, the City will provide for translation/interpretation services for other public communications beyond the workshop identified in the RFP.

Q3: Is there a culture master plan for Iqaluit? Are cultural facilities and programs considered a part of the project scope.

A3: Culture needs to be incorporated into the activities and programs hosted by Iqaluit Recreation. For example, the programs and activities of the Elder's Qammaq are reflective of Inuit culture. There is no culture master plan at this time.

Q4: Who would be part of a City steering committee for this project? Could we count on being able to contact the key players over the summer for teleconferences or working meetings?

A4: The steering committee is comprised of City Recreation staff, and members of City Council. Recreation staff and/or members of the steering committee
