**By signing the ABOVE applicant has read and hereby agrees to abide by the following restrictions:**

- At no time will any materials other than untreated wood or traditional observation of arctic heather be ignited; or allowed to burn;
- Do not burn if wind conditions are such that burning ember, ash, particles, or smoke are, or could pose a threat or inconvenience to other persons or properties.
- No materials will be ignited or allowed to burn unless said materials is at least 30 meters (or distance specified by the City Fire Department) from any structures, tundra, or other combustible materials.
- From the time of ignition until complete extinguishments an adequate number of adults supervisors will be at the location to monitor and control the fire. They will also be responsible to ensure that the area is secure so as to protect the safety of all minors.
- Immediately prior to ignition and during the fire, there will be adequate tools and supplies (water, shovels, sand, etc.) at the site for the control and extinguishments of the fire. The City Fire Department will advise the applicant of the appropriate type and amount required.
- At no time will the fire be allowed to reach a size that is, or could be beyond the reasonable capability of the applicant/supervisor to control and extinguish.
- No more than 0.5 Liters of any flammable/ combustible liquid maybe used, as an accelerant without specific written permission from the City Fire Department and the ignition of said approved amount of accelerant, must be supervised by the City Fire Department.
- The applicant and/or the corporation, agents, club or groups represented by the applicant assumes full responsibility for A) any cost incurred by the City, including wear or damages to equipment, to control or extinguish the fire and/or fires caused by the said fire or its products.
- All residual materials not consumed by the fire and considered as garbage must be removed within twenty-four hours from the time of extinguishments stipulated in the permits to a proper garbage receptacle or to a designated dump. No individuals or businesses shall be issued burn permits for the intent of burning garbage.
