BY-LAW #772

LANDFILL FIRE SUPPRESSION BY-LAW

A by-law of the Municipal Corporation of the City of Iqaluit in Nunavut further to the August 1, 2014, proceedings of the Council of the City of Iqaluit ("Council") pursuant to the *Cities Towns and Villages Act*, S.Nu. 2003.

WHEREAS

Section 9 of the *Cities Towns and Villages Act*, 1988, as amended, provides that the powers and duties of a municipal corporation are to be exercised and performed by the Council;

Section 10(1) of the *Cities Towns and Villages Act* provides that Council shall exercise its powers and perform its duties by resolution or by bylaw;

Sections 98 of the *Cities, Towns and Villages Act* provides that Council may pass bylaws in relation to fire prevention;

Section 99 of the *Cities, Towns and Villages Act* provides that Council may enter into agreements in relation to fire fighting staff and equipment;

On August 1, 2014, Council passed motion 14-236 specifying that the City shall take all actions necessary to extinguish the landfill fire (the "**Resolution**") as follows:

That Council allocate all financial assistance needed to try to extinguish the fire starting immediately, independent of the final costs of the operation, in order to protect lives, property and the environment.

In accordance with the Resolution, it is believed to be in the best interest of the City to adopt the following by-law to grant the Mayor, Council and appropriate City officials the authority and direction to do all things necessary to give effect to the Resolution notwithstanding Purchasing, Tendering, Contract and Local Incentive By-Law 581 for the purpose of suppressing or extinguishing the landfill fire (the "**Landfill Fire Suppression By-Law**").

THEREFORE the Council of the City of Iqaluit enacts as follows:


1. The preamble is incorporated by reference into this Landfill Fire Suppression By-Law.
2. The Landfill Fire Suppression By-Law grants Council and appropriate City officials the authority and direction to do all things necessary to give effect to the Resolution notwithstanding Purchasing, Tendering, Contract and Local Incentive By-Law 581 for the purpose of suppressing or extinguishing the landfill fire.


3. In furtherance of this By-law, the Mayor and appropriate officials of the City are hereby authorized and directed to do all things necessary to give effect to the action of the Council referred to in the proceeding section.
4. The Mayor, or in the absence of the Mayor, the Deputy Mayor and/or the Deputy Mayor and the Chief Administrative Officer or in the absence of the Chief Administrative officer his delegate, are authorized and directed to execute all documents necessary in that behalf and to affix thereto the corporate seal of the City of Iqaluit.

EFFECTIVE DATE, this by-law shall come into effect the date upon third and final reading.




