THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF IQALUIT, NUNAVUT BY-LAW No. 1030 TRAFFIC SAFETY BY-LAW AMENDMENT

A By-law of the Municipal Corporation of the City of Iqaluit.

WHEREAS Council enacted the Traffic Safety By-Law #894 on June 9th, 2020 pursuant to the provision of the Cities, Towns and Villages Act, R.S.N.W.T. 1988, c.C-8, and the Traffic Safety Act R.S.N.W.T. 1988, c M-16; and

WHEREAS Council now wishes to amend By-Law #894;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the City of Iqaluit, in a regular session, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. Delete Section 12 in "Schedule B" "Powers of Seizure and Impoundment" and replace with the following:

Section 12.1 Powers of Seizure and Impoundment
The associated costs pertaining to the towing and impoundment of the vehicle, including towing fee, daily impound fee and administration fee, can be found in the Consolidated Fees and Charges By-law, as amended and updated by Council from time to time.

SEVERABILITY

If any provision of this by-law is declared invalid because of any work, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this by-law or any documents, which form part of this by-law or an application thereof to any person, or circumstance is declared invalid, the remaining provisions shall not be affected thereby but shall remain in force.

EFFECTIVE DATE

This By-law shall come into force upon receiving third and final reading.
