Bags, gloves, and other supplies will be available for pickup starting at 8:30 AM outside the following locations across the City:

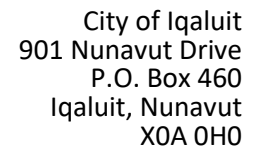
- City Hall Arnaitok Arena
- Iqaluit Centennial Library
- Abe Opik Hall in Apex
- Arctic Winter Games Arena
- Iqaluit Masjid Mosque in Road to Nowhere

Due to COVID-19, the City has created solutions to ensure that proper social distancing and sanitation measures are in effect. However, that means we are not able to host a BBQ this year. To celebrate remotely, there will be a social media photo submission with a draw for prizes to begin on Friday, June 19th and end on Saturday, June 20th. All participants are to wear gloves supplied by the City and to adhere to the social distancing protocols that are in place by the Government of Nunavut. We recommend that you wear a mask when social distancing may not be possible.
