

Public Service Announcement

Water Shut Down and Precautionary Boil Water Advisory – 100's, 200's and 300's

June 02, 2022 – Iqaluit, Nunavut

Please be advised of a water shut down on **Friday**, **June 3**, **2022** from approximately **9:00** a.m. to **5:00** p.m. to allow for necessary water infrastructure work.

Location of water interruption: 100's, 200's and 300's.

The City of Igaluit is issuing a precautionary boil water advisory for the above addresses.

During a precautionary boil water advisory, the City recommends that all water for consumption is brought to a rolling boil for a **minimum** of one full minute.

It is recommended that all water be boiled for the following uses:

- Drinking;
- Preparing infant formulas;
- Preparing juices and ice cubes;
- Washing fruits and vegetables;
- Cooking; or
- Brushing of teeth

Water can be boiled in either a pot or kettle on a stove or an electric kettle without an automatic shut-off. It is not necessary to boil water for anything other than the above list.

The City of Iqaluit will release a Public Service Announcement when the boil water advisory is lifted.
