

## Water Shut Down and Precautionary Boil Water Advisory – 100's, 200's and 300's

Please be advised of a water shut down on **Wednesday, June 8, 2022 from approximately 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.** to allow for necessary water infrastructure work.

The City of Iqaluit is issuing a precautionary boil water advisory for the above addresses.

It is recommended that all water be boiled for the following uses:

- Drinking;
- Preparing infant formulas;
- Preparing juices and ice cubes;
- Washing fruits and vegetables;
- Cooking; or
- Brushing of teeth

Water can be boiled in either a pot or kettle on a stove or an electric kettle without an automatic shut-off. It is not necessary to boil water for anything other than the above list.

The City of Iqaluit will release a Public Service Announcement when the boil water advisory is lifted.


