

Water Shut Down and Precautionary Boil Water Advisory – 171, 172, 173, 174, 175, 176, 177, 179, 181, 185 A-F, 187 A-F, 189 A-F, 358, 359, 670, 672, 673, 674, 675, 677, 679, 681, 683, 685 A-C.

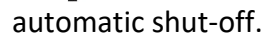
Please be advised of a water shut down on **Tuesday, June 3, from approximately 1:00PM to 5:00PM** to allow for necessary water infrastructure work.

When water pressure drops, the Chief Public Health Officer of Nunavut automatically issues a precautionary boil water advisory. If this water interruption affects your residence, you are under a precautionary boil water advisory.

During a precautionary boil water advisory, the City recommends that all water for consumption is brought to a rolling boil for a **minimum** of one full minute.

- drinking;
- preparing infant formulas;
- preparing juices and ice cubes;
- washing fruits and vegetables;
- cooking; or
- brushing of teeth.
