



Public Service Announcement

July 18, 2014 (Iqaluit, Nunavut) City of Iqaluit would like to remind residents, effective immediately, residents are asked to separate their cardboard and household waste, due to the smoldering fire at the landfill site.

Paper products such as cardboard paper, corrugated cardboard paper, cereal boxes, juice and milk boxes and kleenex should be put in a large blue bag, if possible, or bundled up and tied to keep from spreading around town.

Residents and contractors are strongly advised to separate treated from untreated wood waste before bringing it to the temporary site where the wood is being dropped off at the north end of the landfill site.

Residents are welcome to pick-up wood during regular working hours, Monday to Friday.

The compacted cardboard waste and paper products will be stored away safely until proper equipment is available to be burnt in a controlled manner. For more information, please contact Joe Brown, Operations Superintendent, Public Works at 222-2956.
