

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF IQALUIT, NU
TAXI BY-LAW AMENDMENT No. 936

WHEREAS, the Cities, Towns and Villages Act, SNu., 2003, c.02, s. 113 provides for the passage of by-laws to licence and regulate the operators and operation of vehicles carrying passengers for compensation; and,

AND WHEREAS the Cities, Towns and Villages Act, SNu., 2003, c.02, s. 110 provides for the passage of by-laws to classify, licence and regulate businesses; and,

BEING A BY-LAW of the Municipality of Iqaluit, NU, to provide for the supervision, licensing, and regulating of businesses, operators and vehicles carrying passengers for compensation within the City of Iqaluit, NU.

NOW THEREFORE PURSUANT to the provisions of the Cities, Towns and Villages Act, SNu., 2003, c.02, s. 113 and 110 the Council of the Municipality of Iqaluit, NU, in regular session duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. Amends Bylaw No. 590.
2. Adds a new Schedule, Schedule "L" Taxi Fare Increase Schedule.
3. This schedule shall be amended by the CAO as and when required, or by way of Council Motion without the requirement to amend this bylaw.





**SCHEDULE ‘T’
BY-LAW # 936**

SCHEDULE OF TARIFFS

1.	Within the City of Iqaluit including Apex and the Causeway but excluding Upper Base Elders 60+ Fare remains \$5.00; driver may require identification.	\$8.75 (effective Date May 1, 2022)
2.	From the Causeway to Apex or to the Road To Nowhere (summer) from any location. Taxi will only travel on roads maintained by the City.	\$10.75 per person one way
3.	Children under ten years of age accompanied by an adult going to the same place are to be carried free. This includes all areas of Iqaluit where Tariffs apply.	Free
4.	For hand-to-hand deliveries (e.g. letters, food, etc.) not to exceed 20 kgs.	Double the regular fare.
5.	Taxi and driver rental	\$80.00 per hour
6.	A drop-off is considered as a trip (e.g. from home to babysitter and babysitter to place of work would each be considered separate trips.	\$8.75 per drop off
7.	Driver must advise passenger in advance about fee for any waiting time over five minutes.	\$1.00 per minute after five minutes
8.	Carrying of animals loose or in cages will be charged full adult rate.	\$8.75
9.	Taxi Driver may request fare to be paid in advance	
10.	For more than 2 pieces of luggage or packages/boxes, but shall not include grocery bagged items.	\$2.00 per excess piece
